





2024 Belleville Main Street Marathon & Half Marathon Saturday, September 28

Presented by Toolen's Running Start and the Belleville Running Club

COURSE: Both races will begin and end on Main Street near First Street in historic downtown Belleville, IL, and include portions of America's longest Main Street and other city streets. The full marathon also includes a section of the paved MetroBikeLink trail. The course includes enthusiastic volunteers who provide top-notch course support.

TIME: 7 AM start time for both races, with course support ending at 2 PM for the full and 10:30 AM for the half.

ENTRY FEES (Entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable):

Make checks payable to Belleville Running Club. Event shirts are guaranteed through Sept. 14 registrations.

COURSE SUPPORT: Hydration stations will be located about every 2 miles and include water and lemon lime Gatorade. Energy gels will be provided at a couple of these stations. Please note that **full marathon** participants must be at mile 13 by 10:23 AM or they will be transported by vehicle to another point on the course and allowed to cross the finish line with an *unofficial* time. **Half marathon** participants must be at mile 6.5 by 8:50 AM and complete the course by 10:30 AM to receive an official race time. If runners of either race are on the course after volunteers have been dismissed, those runners must move to the sidewalks.

RACE SWAG: Event shirts are guaranteed if registration is completed by September 14, and all finishers will receive a 2024 event participant medal. Our post-race party will include food and drink from local businesses, music, and post-race stretching.

AWARDS: For both the full and half marathons, the top 3 overall male and female finishers; top male and female master finishers; and top male and female wheelchair finishers will receive awards. The top 3 finishers in the following age group divisions for the **half marathon** will receive awards: 19 and younger; 20-24; 25-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; and 70 & older. The top 3 finishers in the following age group divisions for the **full marathon** will receive awards: 18-19; 20-24; 25-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; and 70 & older. All finishers will receive a participant medal. Due to liability and safety issues, the **full marathon age limit requirement** of being 18 or older will be strictly enforced. No age limit applies to the half marathon.

PACKET PICKUP: Friday, September 27, from 10 AM to 6:00 PM, Toolen's Running Start, 3260 Greenmount Road, Shiloh, IL 62269 and race morning near the start line from 5:30 to 6:30 AM.
